HLE 604: Change in the undergraduate catalog the BS degree in Physical Education K-12 (564A) as follows:
A. Remove the following core curriculum requirement:
Sociology 2700
B. Add the following to the options for the general education science inquiry sequence: Physics
C. Add PE 1560 to the major requirements

HLE 623: Add to the Undergraduate catalog: PE 1769 Personal Trainer Training (2)
Add to the PE Basic Instruction Program Courses that are offered for wellness literacy credit within the newly adopted general education curriculum.

HLE 694: Change in the undergraduate catalog: PE 3090. Aquatics/Water Safety Instructor/ (2). F;S. as follows:

B. Add PE 1719 as a PE Basic Instruction Program Aquatics course that meets the general education wellness literacy

BIO 24: Designate CI 4900 (Student Teaching) as the “Senior Capstone Experience” for B.S. degree in Biology, Secondary Education (209A/13.1322)[T].

3. Admissions Update: Will be discussed at later meeting.

4. Other:

Dr. Jenkins spoke about the secondary academic concentration (SAC) and the misunderstanding with Gen. Ed. of SAC and the hours exceeding 128 for four-year graduation. Students can graduate in four years dependent upon their selection of courses for their particular field of study. There was discussion of how to help Gen. Ed. and others understand the function of some concentration courses with a suggestion that the College of Education post a thorough check sheet for second academic concentration to the web site in order to alleviate some of the confusion and to create clarity. As a note, SAC actually deepens the content knowledge of teacher education students.

Dr. Duke presented a handout depicting the projections of teacher education enrollment and/or graduation per the edict from the General Assembly for all UNC System colleges and universities. (Handout attached.)

Update on revisioning: Work continues with a variety of task forces to help with this process including but not limited to: Diversity; Technology; Assessment; Teaching in the 21st Century; etc.

A tentative time line is that drafts will be available by Spring Break for aligned standards and core curriculum
